

School of Sports Facebook Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

How it Works

1. Prize draw: between 3pm and 6pm on 27, 29 and 31 August 2023.
2. Te Pūkenga – New Zealand Institute of Skills and Technology trading as Manukau Institute of Technology (“MIT”) is doing a prize draw (“draw”) to celebrate the FIBA Basketball World Cup 2023;
3. To enter the draw, you **must**:
 - (a) have a Facebook profile; and
 - (b) Comment with the final score for the match of the day (on 26, 28 and/or 30 August 2023) and like the corresponding daily post on the MIT School of Sport Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/manukausport>).

8. The winner is to collect their prize at the MIT Otara Campus.
9. A valid current ID (driver’s licence or passport) must be presented by the winner to claim their prize.
10. Any prizes that are unclaimed within [7] days of being drawn may be redrawn and awarded to another winner.
11. Entrants give MIT permission to contact them via their Facebook profile.
